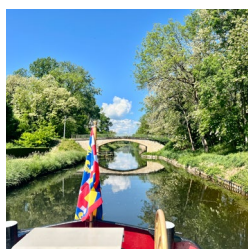

Following a wonderful first Art Cruise aboard Luciole in 2026, Nina returns for another week of expert tuition, painting and sketching along the waterways of Burgundy.

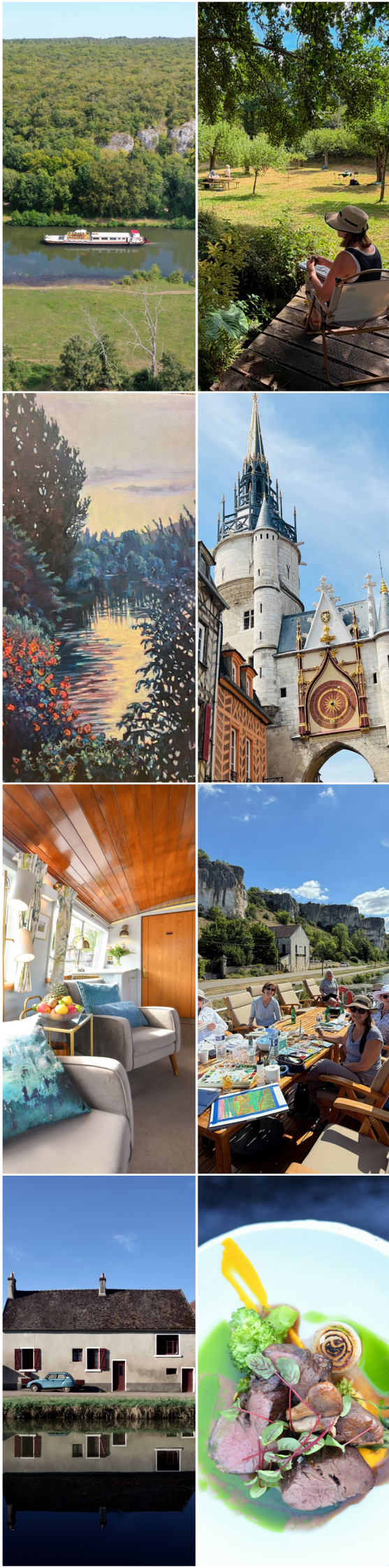
Artists will find inspiration along the River Yonne, from Luciole's deck, beneath the dramatic Rochers du Saussois and in peaceful private French garden.

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Art Cruise itinerary

Sunday

Afternoon transfer from Paris to Auxerre. The Luciole crew welcomes you aboard with a Champagne reception, followed by time to sketch the city's superb skyline, reflecting into the River Yonne.

Monday

Morning cruise out of Auxerre to Vincelles, with wide river scenery and gentle canal stretches. Afternoon visit to Irancy, set in a natural amphitheatre of vineyards and cherry trees, perfect for painting. Wine tasting included.

Tuesday

A morning art class of tuition with Nina on the banks of the River Yonne. Afternoon cruise to Accolay.

Wednesday

Visit to delightful Noyers-sur-Serein, officially one of France's most picturesque villages. Cobble streets, half-timbered houses and flower-decked squares provide characterful subjects. Afternoon cruise to Mailly-le-Château, passing by waterfalls, rustic villages and quaint lockhouses. Time to sketch, bike or stroll the tow path.

Thursday

Morning cruise along sweeping river bends to the dramatic cliffs of Les Rochers du Saussois. Afternoon visit to Vézelay, and the UNESCO-listed Basilica of Sainte Madeleine. The hilltop town and its panoramic views offer a majestic subject for painting. The village has an affinity with artists, with its numerous independent galleries.

Friday

A morning of painting with Nina, in a beautiful local garden. In the afternoon the Luciole cruises to Clamecy, a charming Medieval town of half-timbered houses and numerous waterways that weave around the town. Evening farewell Captain's Dinner.
