Luciole's art week combines cruising the glorious Nivernais Canal with perfect opportunities to paint.

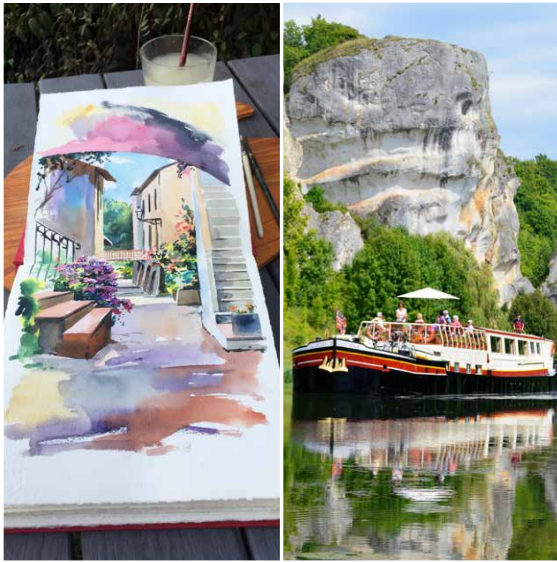

Sunday

Monday

Morning cruise to Vincelles along wide stretches of the River Yonne. Perfect landscape painting opportunities. Afternoon visit to Irancy for art and wine tasting.

Tuesday

After breakfast we drive to Dijon to visit the Musée des Beaux Arts. We lunch in the city, before returning to the Luciole and cruising to our evening mooring in Accolay.

Wednesday

Visit to delightful Noyers-sur Serein for market day, so plenty to sketch. Boutique art and craft shops to visit. The cruise in the afternoon is to Mailly-le-Château.

Thursday

Morning cruise past the Saussoir cliffs with opportunities to paint and sketch. Afternoon visit to the hilltop Basilica of Vézelay, a UNESCO heritage site.

Friday

Morning cruise to Clamecy. Our afternoon visit is to the dramatic Chateau of Bazoches. Sketching opportunities are plentiful. Evening farewell 'Captain's Dinner'.

Saturday

Morning departure, arriving in Paris at lunchtime.
